The Canning 1612 polishing machine is a traditionally built, heavy duty manual polishing machine renowned for its durability, reliability, and long service life. Primarily designed for use with polishing mops, buffs, and bobs, it is equally suited to a wide range of rotary abrasive tools, including abrasive nylon wheels, flap wheels, deburring wheels, wire wheels, and abrasive brushes.

This polisher featuring one spindle (second could be made on request) and is powered by a robust high-torque motor. The 1612 remains one of the industry's most widely used polishing machines.
